

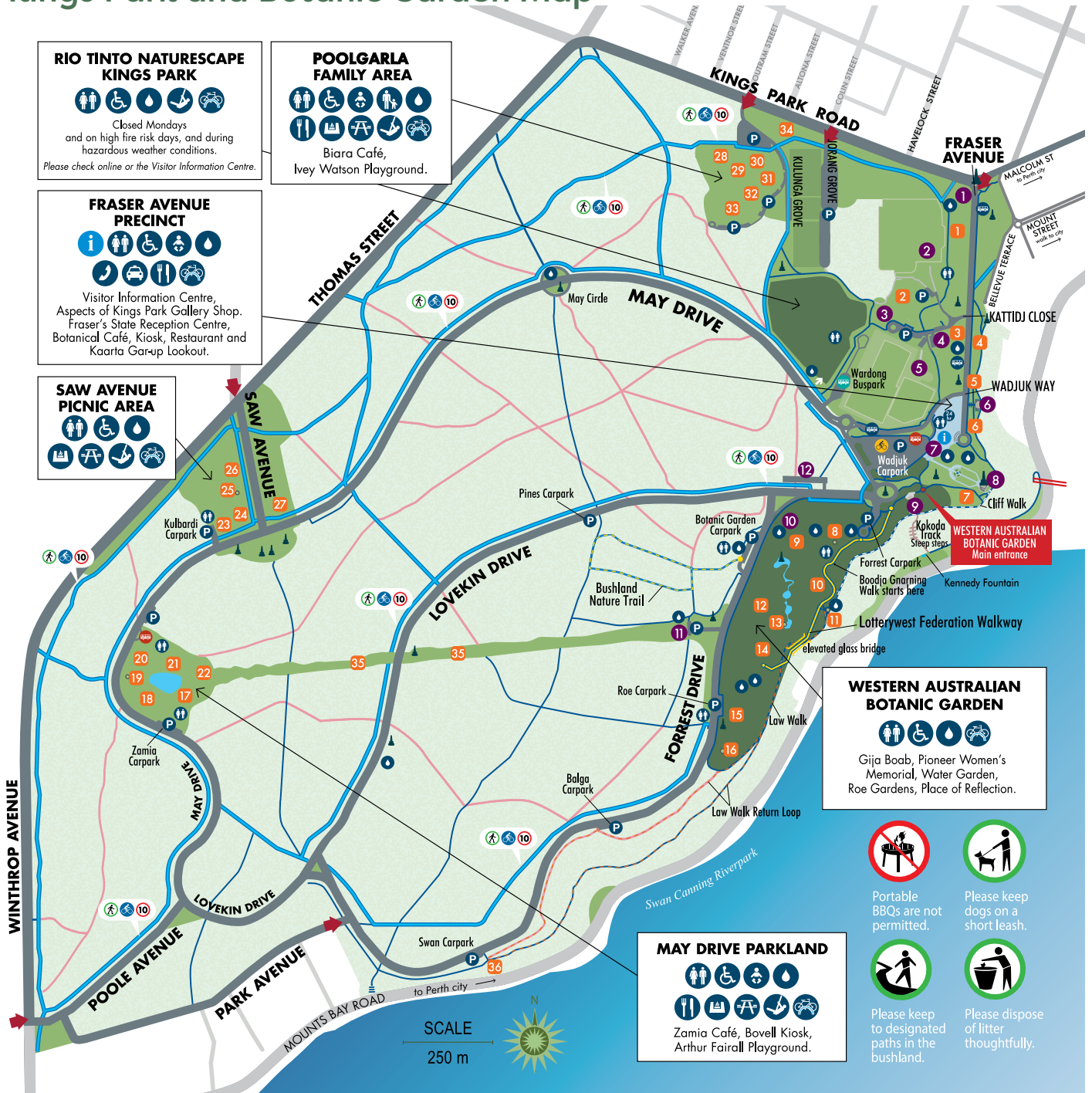

## Welcome to Kings Park and Botanic Garden

### Getting here

Kings Park and Botanic Garden is open 24 hours daily and entry is free.

Free public transport is available between Kings Park and Perth city centre:

- Transperth Bus #935.
- Red CAT Bus travels to West Perth, about a 1 km walk to Kings Park from the drop off point.
- Green CAT Bus operates Monday to Friday, stops just outside the park on Kings Park Road.

### Things to do

- Discover the Western Australian Botanic Garden.
- Book an Aboriginal Cultural Tour of Kings Park.
- Walk amongst the treetops on the Lotterywest Federation Walkway (open 9 am – 5 pm daily).
- See the Gija Jumulu, our 760 year old Boab tree.
- Take a free guided walk with a Kings Park Guide at 10am, 12 noon and 2 pm daily.
- Follow the Boodja Gnarning Aboriginal Walk Trail.
- Shop at Aspects of Kings Park Gallery Shop.
- Take the family to May Drive Parkland, the Lotterywest Family Area or Rio Tinto Naturescape Kings Park.
- Enjoy an outdoor concert, film or play during summer events season.
- Visit the Kings Park Festival held each September.
